STABLING - Stalls for everyone (except paid early arrivals) will be ready on Thursday after 12 pm.

The Horse Park will be cleaning up from previous events and all early arrivals need to stay out of their way. Heavy equipment will be operating in the barn area and around the park until Thursday at noon.

SHAVINGS - All stalls come with one bag of shavings. Additional shavings are \$12 each. Please order more shavings from Laurie (910) 585-0320 or laurierose801@gmail.com by Wed April 5th at 5 pm to assure they are available when you arrive. Additional shavings will only be available once a day for pick up between 4 and 5 pm. No is hay available for sale.

SHARING - A sharing form must be sent to the secretary for sharing any grooms, navigators or carriages. For Dressage or Cones we need to know by <u>Sunday April 2nd</u>. Sharing for marathon must be turned into the Secretary by <u>Friday April 7th</u> by noon. No accommodations can be made after those times as the schedule will be final.

WHERE TO RIDE OR DRIVE - No riding or driving in any of the arenas, or on the sand pads. You may ride or drive on the grass around the arenas on the stable side of Montrose Rd. Riding and driving will be allowed on the other side of Montrose Rd after Thursday at noon.
