General Information

Marathon course will be open for walking Friday, May 17 weather permitting. Weather may restrict use of motorized vehicles on course. All dogs must be leashed at all times. Loose dogs will be kept for you at the show office. There is a \$50 fee to collect your dog. Participation on course "twice only" for drivers, navigators, or equipment, subject to scheduling requirements. Only requests included with entry form will be considered. Wheel track measurement required on Entry Form and will be verified at dressage. Only authorized vehicles will be allowed in Pine Meadow on Sunday, May 19th during the Marathon. A valid drivers license is required to operate any motorized vehicle on the grounds.
